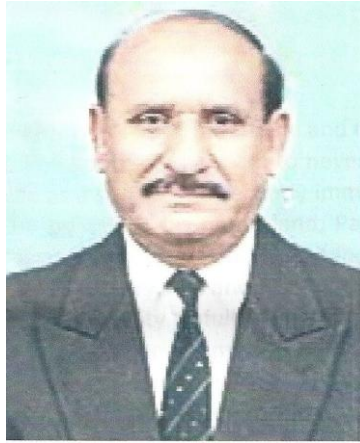


SHAMIM IQBAL PIRACHA

I was born in Pakistan. At the age of 16 years, I passed my Secondary School Examination from Government high school, Bhera, District Sargodha, Punjab (Pakistan). In 1960, I joined Government service in Pakistan Railways as Assistant Station Master. I did my graduation during my service in 1966 from the University of Punjab (Pakistan) as an external student.
